



Equine Emergency Evacuation of Yavapai County Preparedness Check List - Personal

A “Go Bag” is to be in the vehicle that the volunteer drives to the Staging Area.

All EEE Personnel should have a “Go Bag” containing the following:

(Must Haves)

- Emergency contact and medical emergency information
- Fanny pack or backpack
- Water – 3 gallons minimum in vehicle
- Shelf stable snacks
- Gloves – disposable latex and work
- Eyecare
 - Protective goggles capable of withstanding heat
 - Sunglasses
 - Reading glasses prescription eyewear, and spare contact lenses and solution
- Cell Phone and Charger
- Boots
- Flashlight or Lantern
- N-95 Respirator Mask
- First Aid Kit

(Nice to Haves)

Having as many of the following as possible will make you safer and more comfortable during your shift.
