



Equine Emergency Evacuation of Yavapai County

Preparedness Check List - Family

All family members should know where these items are and consider having a family evacuation drill. These items should be in a dry accessible place and are in addition to the personal “Go Bag”.

- Maintain Safe Emergency Water Supply (minimum 3 days for evacuation, 14 for home.)
- Maintain Emergency Food Supply (minimum 3 days for evacuation, 14 for home.)
 - Food should be non-perishable and easy to prepare. Rotate stock so it stays in date.
 - Keep in easily accessible place that seems least disaster-prone.
- Flashlight and extra batteries.
- Battery powered or solar/hand crank radio and cell phone charger.
- First Aid Kit for humans and animals.
- Personal and pet medications and related supplies (batteries for hearing aid, syringes for injectable drugs, vet wrap, etc.)
- Multi-Purpose Tool for shutting off power, gas and water.
- Sanitation and personal hygiene items (toilet paper, ‘baby wipes’, shampoo, etc.)
- Keep copies of the following documents. Consider storing copies in cloud and originals in safety deposit box or a Fire Proof Strong box that you can take with you.
 - Medication List and Pertinent Medical info (Doctor and phone number, health insurance, etc.)
 - Proof of Address
 - Deed to Home or lease agreement.
 - Passports
 - Birth certificates
 - Social Security cards
 - Insurance policies
 - Family and Emergency Contact information
 - Video of house and property
- Cell Phones and Chargers, solar and car plug-in
- Extra Cash (Note: if ATMs are not working, you will need cash)
- Blankets, Sleeping Bags and Pillows
- Maps of the area
- Two Way Radios (walkie-talkies or better)
- At least two or three changes of clothes for each family member
- Shoes and boots
- Spare house, property and vehicle keys
- Duct Tape
- Liquid Household Bleach without any perfumes, dyes or additives (at least one gallon)
- Entertainment items: playing cards, games, sketchbook, journal, knitting, etc.
- Basic Tool kit: hammer, nails, screw drivers (Philips and Slot), adjustable wrench, bolt cutters
- Full fuel tank(s), jumper cables and spare tires/jack in all evacuation vehicles



Assume the Family may be away for an extended period of time. Call 911 to find out where the Red Cross Shelter is located during an evacuation.
