



Equine Emergency Evacuation of Yavapai County

Preparedness Check List - Animals

Volunteer's Animals: The Volunteer's animals should be prepared.

EEE recommends that ALL large and small animals be microchipped and ownership registered to microchips in advance of any emergency or disaster.

Small Animal Supplies:

- Collar, Leash or harness
- 3 days or more of food if evacuating, minimum 10 days of food if sheltering in place
- 10 days water if sheltering in place
- Carrier
- Water / Food bowl
- Sleeping pad or blanket
- Travel Crate with your name and mobile number on crate
- Vaccination, Health and Ownership Records attached to crate and a copy stored on cloud
- Medicines and Prescriptions
- First Aid / Home Health Kit (Your veterinarian can provide recommendation for items to include)

Large Animal Supplies:

- Leather or cotton halters and leads
- 3 days or more of food if evacuating
- Fly masks and other comfort items for equines
- Identify ownership of all animals (microchip in advance, write mobile number on hoof with permanent marker, spray paint or use livestock crayon to write mobile number on flank, braid luggage tag in mane, take photo of each animal standing with you including showing all unique identifying marks such as brand or tattoo, coloring or markings)
- Vaccination and Health Records on each animal with copy stored on cloud
- Medicines and Prescriptions
- First Aid/ Home Health Kit (Your veterinarian can provide recommendation for items to include).
